Ellery Queen' is a popular pseudonym that was created by two cousins; Frederic Dannay and Manfred Lee. The fictional detective is popularly known as the American Whodunit' celebrity, competing Nero Wolfe. Mystery Writers of America give these awards to honor the best in mystery fiction and nonfiction produced the previous year. (We list only the fiction awards.) The awards began in 1946 and are named in honor of Edgar Allan Poe. (Grand Master Awards also listed on one page.) In my previous post, I reviewed a short story by Rintaro Norizuki, "Toshi densetsu pazuru" ("An Urban Legend Puzzle," 2001), which cleverly used the popularity of urban legends as a premise for a good, old-fashioned detective story, but Japan is home to much older, often more rural legends of monsters, spirits and demons – commonly known as yokai.
