Brief History of ASCII code: The American Standard Code for Information Interchange, or ASCII code, was created in 1963 by the "American Standards Association" Committee or "ASA", the agency changed its name in 1969 by "American National Standards Institute" or "ANSI" as it is known since. ASCII Table and Description. ASCII stands for American Standard Code for Information Interchange. Computers can only understand numbers, so an ASCII code is the numerical representation of a character such as 'a' or '@' or an action of some sort. Codes 32-127 are common for all the different variations of the ASCII table, they are called printable characters, represent letters, digits, punctuation marks, and a few miscellaneous symbols. You will find almost every character on your keyboard. Character 127 represents the command DEL. Complete ASCII Table. ASCII - The American Standard Code for Information Interchange is one of the most important encodings for characters. Its characteristics are that it is quite old and quite small compared to newer encodings like UNICODE, but it still is alive as a basic standard for uncountable applications. - Complete Ascii Code Table
